- Everyone stops at stop signs
- Do not proceed through a yellow
- Do not turn on red in a group ride
- No alcoholic beverages during rides
- At the destination the ride is officially over
- Pre-ride meeting is 15 minutes before ride departs
- Advise every one of the destination and planned stops
- Find out who has a medical kit
- Two second following distance
- Obay all road signals and signs
- Watch the bike behind you for indication of problem
- May need to put on flashers and pull over
- Reviewed hand signals
- The incident report must be completed if there is a serious accident
- Forms for minors must be completed
- Reviewed May's ride schedule
- Opened floor to questions and someone asked if trikes stay in back. Our club's rule is that they stay in back due to blocking the view. Also noted that trikes ride in the center of lane.
